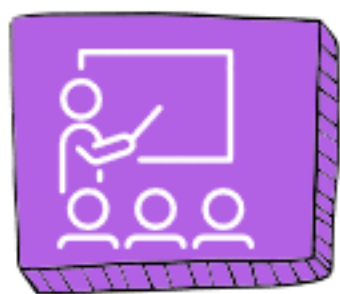


Charities Capability Fund (CCF) Training Grant

Details of Grant	Who can qualify for CCF – Training Grant?	Funding Quantum	How to Apply?
Training courses (local classroom-based courses and local/overseas online courses) in key governance and management areas such as: - Human Resource and Volunteer Management - Board Governance - Strategic Planning - Financial Management, Internal Controls and Risk Management - Impact Measurement - Public Image/Communications The 4 training programmes under GovernWell series are eligible for CCF Training Grant.	- Governing board members of charities [NEW] Sub-committee members of charities - Staff who have served in the charities for at least 6 months with an official designation	Singaporeans/ Permanent Residents: Up to 80% course fee, capped at \$1,000 per course or \$500/full-day (8hrs) or \$250/half-day (4hrs per participant), whichever is lower Employment Pass/ Work Permit Holders/ S Pass Holders: Up to 60% course fee, capped at \$750 per course or \$375/full-day (8hrs) or \$187.50/half-day (4hrs per participant), whichever is lower	- Applications for CCF must be submitted via OurSG Grants (OSG) Portal. - For CCF – Training Grant, the application must be submitted at least one (1) month before commencement of the course.
